Assesses, provides direct intervention or referrals to service providers/programs related to addictive patterns of behavior; concurrent disorders; the impact of intergenerational addictions.

General Responsibilities:

- Interpret and conform to federal, provincial, and local laws, as well as Society Constitution & Bylaws.
- Comply with the Code of Ethics for Alcohol and Drug Service Providers, Ministry of Health
- Advise the Executive Director relative to the needs and opportunities for the program

- Meeting with clients to evaluate their health and substance use/abuse issues
