- > Firsthand knowledge of Aboriginal/Metis philosophies and values of varied culture and traditions
- Comprehensive understanding of BC's Child Care Licensing Regulations/Aboriginal Head Start Childcare Principals and Guidelines
- > Demonstrated Goal setting, critical thinking, problem solving and organization skills
- > Ability to comply with policies and procedures regarding privacy, confidentiality, record keeping, and reporting
- Directing staff, volunteers and placement students
- > Responsible for the constant supervision, safety, and well-being in a classroom of students and volunteers
- Plans and implements developmentally appropriate curriculum which includes activities, and experiences for children between the ages of newborn- 5 years of ages, focusing on the age range of children I the room you are positioned for
